





**ABSOLUTE RESPECT

The foundation of the *Ecole de Légèreté* (School of Lightness) is an efficient training concept fully respecting the nature of the horse, developed by the French riding master **Philippe Karl**, former Ecuyer of the Cadre Noir in Saumur, France.

The central principle of the School is absolute respect for the horse. For this reason, the philosophy of Légèreté strictly rejects any method of training that constrains the horse into fixed positions. It excludes any use of force or coercive artificial aids – including auxiliary reins and tightly closed nosebands.

**At the heart of the *Ecole de Légèreté* is a trusting dialogue between horse and rider**, which enables the rider to promote and optimally develop the aptitudes of any horse. The aim of this versatile approach is to foster an expressive, joyful and cooperative horse that always responds to the lightest of aids.


## CLASSICAL RIDING IN THE LIGHT OF MODERN DISCOVERIES

The *Ecole de Légèreté* combines tried and tested principles with modern knowledge. It is based on the teachings of classical riding masters such as Xenophon, Pluvinel, La Guérinière, Hünersdorf, Baucher, L'Hotte and Oliveira. These teachings are then considered in the light of the latest findings in fields such as anatomy, physiology, locomotion and balance, psychology and ethology.

The result of this synthesis is a logical and understandable training concept with clear principles and practices that fully respect the nature of the horse, which can be applied to all breeds and in all equestrian disciplines. In this way, the *Ecole de Légèreté* opens the door to High School riding for any motivated rider – even with a perfectly “ordinary” horse.
